For your information, the European Parliament published a study entitled "Employee Financial Participation in Companies' Proceeds" in September 2012". The Authors of the study were ordered by the President of the civil Court of Brussels on 6 June 2014 to have the study removed by the European Parliament.

The authors of the study are a consortium made of ECORYS Nederland BV and CASE - Center for Social and Economic Research (Poland), represented by Professors Jens Lowitzsch and Iraj Hashi.

During the pleadings and according to CASE findings, Prof. Lowitzsch presented himself as a Law Professor of the University of Francfort and of Berlin".

Please confirm that M. Lowitzsch is really a professor at the University of Berlin.


